Award-winning acrobatic theatre, *me me me...* makes its English debut in Montreal on Geordie's Mainstage

Montreal, January 25, 2007 – Geordie Productions is thrilled to present *me me me...* a whimsical, acrobatic-movement production by Montreal's circus-inspired **DynamO Théâtre**, February 16th – 25th at the D.B. Clarke Theatre.

With over 255 performances under its belt in three different languages, this award-winning production has toured across Canada, Belgium, France, Spain, the United Kingdom and the United States. The original French-language version *moi moi moi...* delighted sold-out audiences last year in Montreal. As part of its **Montreal Mainstage Series**, Geordie is proud to present the show for its English debut in Montreal.

Using gymnastics, juggling and stunts not to be tried at home, *me me me...* tells the story of a studious but mischievous elementary school class where one student is gradually rejected by her fellow classmates for being too eager in answering the teacher's question. Written by Lise Vaillancourt and directed by Robert Dion, *me me me...* captivates young and old alike with its acrobatic movement reflecting both the real world's enthusiasm and excitement and the inner world's fragile emotions and anxieties.

Based in Montreal, DynamO Théâtre is an internationally renowned theatre company whose work focuses on developing, producing and performing Theatre of Acrobatic Movement productions. DynamO Théâtre was founded in 1981 by several Montreal artists with varying backgrounds in gymnastics, theater, mime and juggling with the vision of creating a dynamic theatrical experience combining movement with drama. Since its debut, the group has toured worldwide, performing in theatre festivals on five continents.
